

## Kathleen O'Keefe Reed Bio

The Rev. Kathleen O'Keefe Reed serves as Director of Advancement at the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Gettysburg. Prior to returning to Gettysburg in spring, 2007, she served for 25 years as a pastor of congregations in Connecticut, Vermont, and Massachusetts. Between 1992 and 2000, she served as Assistant to the Bishop of the New England Synod. Reed is a graduate of Boston University (B.S. in Public Communication) and the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Gettysburg (M.Div., 1980). Her theological studies included Gettysburg Seminary's Washington House of Studies, the Bodelschwingschen Anstaltten of Bethel in Bielefeld, Germany, and Georg August Universitaet in Goettingen, Germany. She has also studied at Middlebury College's Bread Loaf School of English.

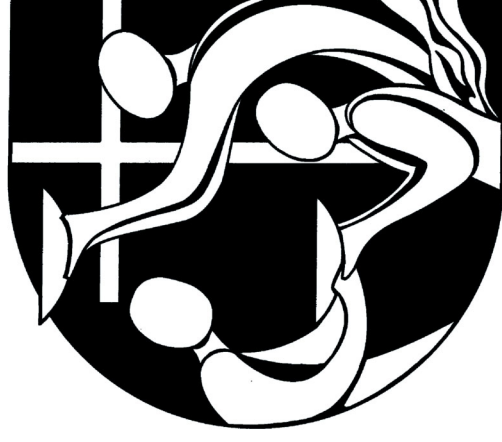
